\* Minimum residency requirement: 30 of the student's last 36 credits must be completed at Webster University.

<sup>^</sup> Minimum of 24 of the 36 required credits must be at the 3000 level or higher. Students must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA in the language courses at the 3000 and higher. Nine (9) hours must be successfully completed at Webster University at the 3000 level or higher including an advanced language course, a literature course and a culture course. Also, a study abroad experience of at least one semester in a country where the target language is spoken is required. A portfolio review and demonstration of oral proficiency must be passed in a departmental overview.

<sup>#</sup> Courses completed with a grade lower than C do not count toward fulfilling specific core requirements of either the major or general education.

<sup><</sup> Language courses taken at the community college not listed with equivalencies at Webster University may be counted toward the appropriate major as part of the 12 credits acceptable at the 1000 and 2000 level.

<sup>+</sup> Students who complete an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree before transferring to Webster University will have completed all of their general education requirements. Please refer to Webster University's Transfer Guide on General Education Requirements for further information.

Transfer students should contact the International Languages and Cultures Department for evaluation of language skills and placement in appropriate courses.
